

Learning Management System user guide: Review Status

The **Review Status** feature allows students to indicate when they have reviewed an item. Subject co-ordinators can monitor student review status using the **Performance Dashboard**.

ENABLING REVIEW STATUS

1. Using the *Subject Menu* of your subject, navigate to the area where the item you wish to apply review status resides.
2. Click **Edit View**.
3. Click the **Manage** button associated with your chosen item.
4. Click **Review Status**.
5. Select **Enable**.
6. Click **Submit** and then **OK** on the following receipt page.

CREATING A REVIEW STATUS RULE WITH ADAPTIVE RELEASE

Review Status can be enabled using the **Adaptive Release** feature. By creating an adaptive release rule on an item, students will not be able to view that item until they have reviewed another item.

1. Using the *Subject Menu* of your subject, navigate to the area where the item you wish to manage with adaptive release resides.
2. Click **Edit View**.
3. Click the **Manage** button associated with your chosen item.
4. Under the *Review Status* heading, click **Browse**.
5. Using the *Subject Map*, select the item you wish students to review.
6. Click **Submit** and then **OK** on the following receipt page.
